Maryville Village Hall to be closed to the public

In an effort to help prevent and mitigate the spread of COVID-19, and for the protection and health of our employees and residents, effective November 23, 2020, Maryville Village Hall will be closed to the public until further notice.

During this time, Village facilities will still be in operation and the Village will continue to provide services. However, in-person meetings and face-to-face transactions will be by appointment only. You may call Maryville Village Hall at 618-345-7028 (Monday-Friday: 8 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.) for assistance.

Water and sewer customers are still required to pay any balances. Water and sewer bills may be paid by mail, at the drop-off box located at Village Hall, at all FCB Bank locations (water bill must be presented to make payment), or arrangements for ACH withdrawal from customers' bank accounts may be made. Those forms are available in the vestibule at Village Hall.

Public meetings, including Village Board meetings and committee meetings, will be held virtually until further notice. All meetings will be hosted through the Zoom online platform.

The Maryville Police Department lobby will remain open for walk-in reports and public safety concerns. In the event of an emergency please continue to dial 9-1-1.
