### Maryville Fire Department Smoke Detector Program

The Maryville Fire Department is proud to announce its partnership with the Illinois Fire Safety Alliance (IFSA) and the Office of the Illinois State Fire Marshal (OSFM) to begin providing no-cost (FREE) smoke alarms to the residents of the Village of Maryville and the Maryville Fire Protection District! This program is part of "Camp I Am Me", an organization for children and teenagers ages 8-17 who have experienced injuries from burns.

These organizations will provide the Maryville Fire Department with smoke alarms for single family residences within our village and our fire protection district. All eligible residents will be provided with smoke alarms, limited to 3 (three) per household. The detectors will be installed by members of the Maryville Fire Department at no cost to the homeowner. We will also provide education on fire safety and fire escape planning.

Installation scheduling and proof of ownership may be required. Commercial Businesses and Rental Properties will not be eligible for the program; however, the Maryville Fire Department can still assist with installation and guidance on proper smoke alarm protection.
