Maryville Homecoming Parade 2018

We are accepting any music related entries! Be creative! You have so many choices! Too many ideas to list. Browse Google, consider an entertainer, band, musical, instrument, group—whatever your heart desires that makes you feel like MUSIC!

Please submit your entry with your **float** Title. Reserve your float entry early so that you have your first choice. We discourage duplication of floats. The parade route is a little over a mile. We will organize at the Village Garage; South on Lange, West on 2nd and North on Donk, concluding at the Village Garage.

Please remember the Maryville Homecoming Parade is a children's parade! The support from our community is outstanding and we are grateful to have your entry! Floats are open to families, businesses and organizations, but the guidelines that have been established must be followed. **Inability to follow the guidelines will exclude your entry from the parade. No public officials are allowed—this is a children's parade. Please follow the guidelines below:**

Children's floats are for children ages 7 and under. **Two children under the age of 12 or 1 adult must be able to physically pull the float. It must be built on a child's wagon or comparable 4 wheel base, with a platform no larger than 4 x 10.**

Most floats are deigned to hold anywhere from 1 to 4 children. Floats are built of chicken wire, plywood, Styrofoam, tissue paper and decorated with props. Make sure your float can be pulled easily, and remember to tightly secure your base to the wagon. A float sign will be provided, you must provide the carrier!

Organization/Business Floats must be built on a standard farm hay wagon or trailer no wider than 9 feet. It should be pulled by a regular size car or truck and easily maneuvered on the streets of Mayville.

The float should be decorated in a manner similar to children's floats and have some type of skirting around the wheelbase to cover the underneath of the trailer. All standard hay wagon/trailer floats must provide their own signage. ONLY Business/Organizations within the Maryville Fire District may enter a float pulled by a vehicle. Please limit walkers to no more than 25 individuals.
